At the time of retirement he was responsible for coordination of all research projects pertaining to elephant, buffalo and other large herbivores and rare antelopes in the Kruger National Park, and for all large herbivore censusing in Kruger, Mapungubwe and Marakele National Parks.

He is a Professional Member of the South African Institute of Ecologists. Member of the IUCN's Species Survival Commission's African Elephant and Antelope Specialist Groups and also holds a South African "bird-ringing" permit.

Ian retired from South African National Parks in July 2007 and is currently practicing as an independent environmental consultant, particularly on elephants and birds.
